The team at Moduplay would like to thank the City of Parramatta for the opportunity to engage with you to deliver this exciting project at Somervilla Park, Eastwood.

We applaud Councils design objectives for this park in creating a space that is not only inclusive and accessible, but also provides a wonderful space for children to enjoy a traditional backyard experience and for families to be together. The provision of spaces like these are critical for the development of a strong community.

Design Philosophy

In the following pages and the attached concept drawing sets you will find a comprehensive package of information relating to both our approach to the design of this project and our capability to deliver such a project. We acknowledge the information and briefings provided by Council. This has been very helpful in guiding the design and estimation process.

Moduplay has provided two initial concepts for the main play piece. Council may have preference of one specifically, to join components of each together or to use this as a basis for something completely unique. These are intended to be a starting point only to guide a collaborative process with council should you choose to progress Moduplay.

We also acknowledge the need for quiet, sensory and more junior space and have invested time into ensuring these needs are met in the adjacent spaces.

The need for access is important as well, and we have considered the nearby childcare centre and how the playground will best coexist with this facility.

Compliance and Certification

Moduplay would like to make clear our approach to compliance on this project, especially as it relates to the centre structure. Council have listed several Australian Standards and referred to other legislation in the RFQ documentation. Moduplay is well versed in the Standards pertaining to playground design and construction and we have had experience in incorporating elements of accessibility legislation into our designs.

The applicable Standards and Codes can be summarised as follows:

- Play: AS 4685, 4422, 4486 and 2155
- Accessibility: AS 1428 (DDA)
- Structural: Building Code of Australia (BCA)

We believe a combination of these standards will need to be employed to meet the design and budget objectives of the Somerville Park project. We believe a collaboration between recognised consultants in all three areas will enable a concept such as the options presented in this response to be assessed and certified as compliant.

Collaboration Approach

Moduplay recognises that there will be a close collaboration with Council in working through the concepts provided to further refine and develop the design. We agree that this approach is the best way to achieve a design that meets the requirements of the Council and community groups and provides the best possible outcome for the site.

We have assembled a team structure that enables this process to run smoothly and stay on track in terms of budget, timing and design outcomes. This includes team members from Project Coordination, Project Design, Technical Design and Construction Management, along with the required subject matter experts from across the business and within our network of consultants.

Our experience has shown that once the overall design direction has been agreed including how the design looks and the overall plan layout and elevation, along with agreement around materials and finishes, the best project outcomes are achieved by following a staged 'approval and action' process whereby as details are approved, procurement and production can commence on those elements prior to the approval of the full shop drawing set. More detail on this approach can be discussed in the early stages of the engagement if Moduplay are successful.



We are an Australian Manufacturing business located in Wollongong, NSW – actually making the products we sell.

1989

Right back in 1989 the family owned business began and operated under the brand All Parks Equipment. We put up our first building in Unanderra, a part of Wollongong, which is still used today as our engineer's office and product assembly area. Prior to this (1983 – 1989) Moduplay was a home-based business supplying residential play equipment and backyard cubby houses.

We also supplied our first commercial quality play equipment this year, which was manufactured by a company in Adelaide. Over time it became apparent that supplier would be unable to service the NSW market, so the decision was made to commence manufacturing our own products in Unanderra.

1995

We changed our name to Moduplay. As the business grew rapidly, we needed a name that reflected the popularity of our products. The same year we extended the factory which allowed us to increase production and take our roto moulding process in-house. This improved the service and delivery times that we could offer to our growing list of clients.

2003

This year we doubled the size of our

factory to increase production and keep up with growing demand. It also meant we could work towards our longer-term goal of bringing more specialised manufacturing processes in-house, such as CNC machining and the installation of a powder coating line, giving us much greater control over quality standards and delivery times.

2010

We became known as Moduplay Group
Pty Ltd and we formed 2 distinct divisions.
Moduplay became a division of The
Moduplay Group – still responsible for the
play recreation products. Precinct Street
& Park was formed to offer a dedicated
product range of urban furnishings and
shelters. Same great team, same
manufacturing facilities, all Australian
owned by the same founders... increasing
our product range to service our
customers better.

This allowed greater focus on market segments that, whilst similar, required a dedicated service to allow us to truly take care of our client's needs in these areas.

2015

Once again broadening our offering and servicing our clients better we formed UrbanFiT Outdoor Gyms in 2015. A new division of The Moduplay Group of companies.




Every play element and design is continually risk analysed during design and engineering. In that sense our work is never done. We never let down our guard, and strive for constant improvements to


